Parents attend with their children to all classes which are every other week. Please note the Sacrament session dates on website and include them on your family calendar

\*Mandatory parent class on Sept 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm OR Sept 7<sup>th</sup> at 10am at the Parish which will explain the Sacramental program. You will pick up your Sacramental package at the Parent session which includes diocesan-branded drawstring bag, the Catholic

Children's Bible (primary resource), and various essential materials for the preparation, such as diocesan logo name tags and lanyards, an LED votive candle, a mass card, and a family journal.
