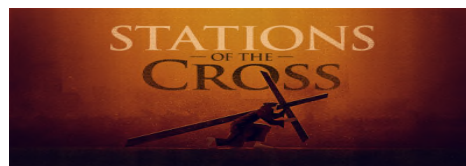

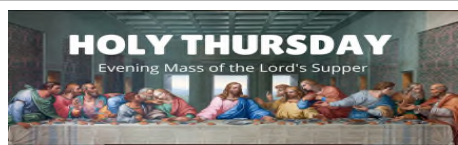

on April 18th (Good Friday) at 10:00 AM.

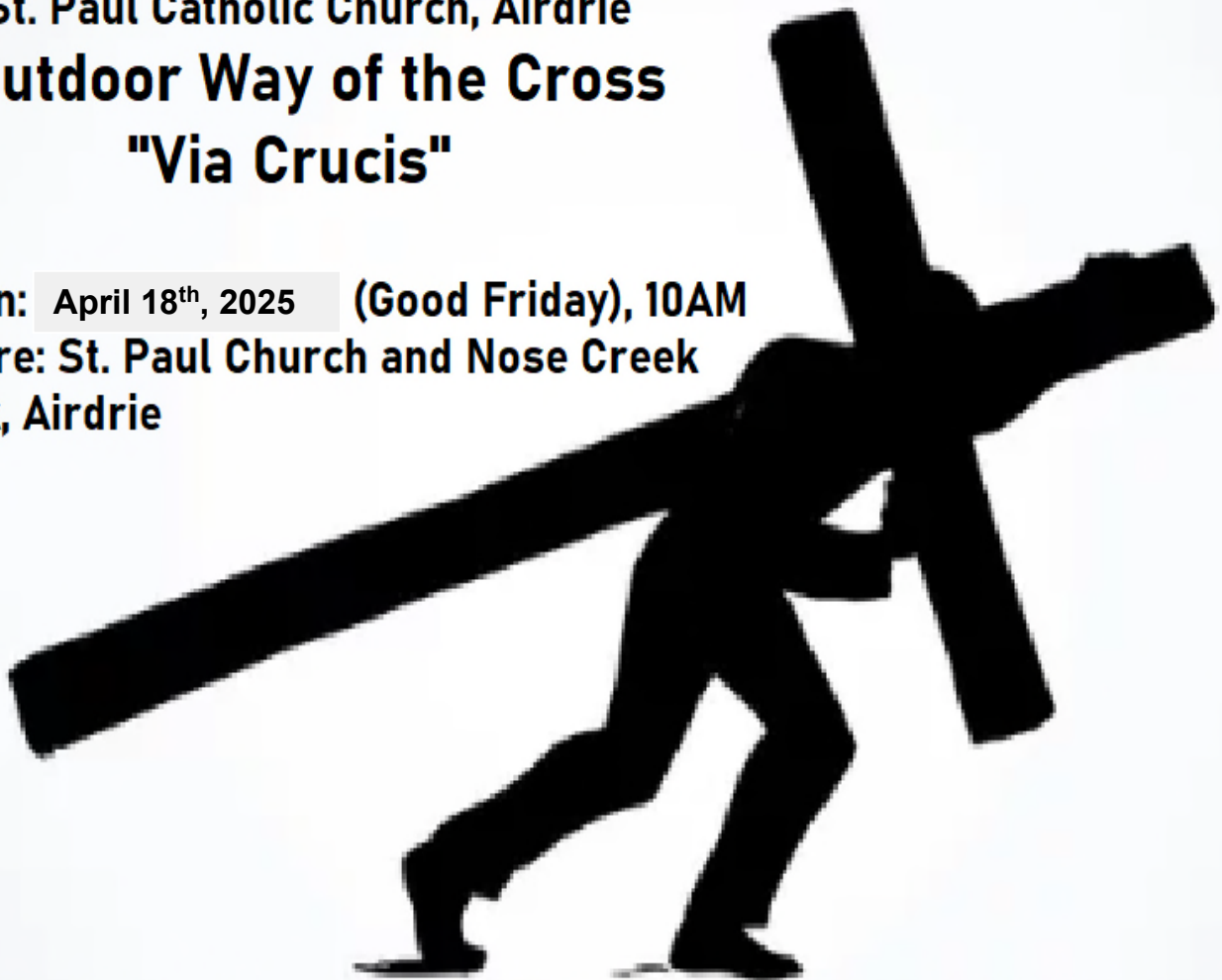
It will be 1.5 hours of procession through Nose Creek Park, located at the back of St. Paul's Church, that starts and ends at St. Paul's Church in the Nave.
